Sodnomdorj Yanjinsuren is a philosopher, who earned her Ph.D in philosophy in 2002.


In 1998, she began her career as a lecturer of philosophy at the National University of Mongolia (NUM) and went on serving as a full-time associate professor and a professor in the Department of Philosophy and Religious studies at the NUM until 2021.

Apart from her 20+ year of teaching career, she also worked as an advisor to the Minister of the Mongolian Trade and Industry in 2008, from 2008-2012 served as an advisor to the Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources of Mongolia, from 2016 to 2020 held position as an advisor to the Deputy Prime Minister of Mongolia, from 2020 to 2021 worked as a Chief advisor to the Deputy Prime Minister of Mongolia as well as the director of Deputy Prime Minister Office.

From 2021 to present Professor S.Yanjinsuren serves as the director of the Documentation and monitoring department at the Office of the President of Mongolia, and works as a contract professor at the NUM same time.

Throughout her career S.Yanjinsuren has maintained an active research agenda in the field of Philosophy and Religious studies namely, Buddhist philosophy and logic, Mongolian religion and philosophy, and has published numerous research works, including 14 monography and joint research work, 65 scholarly articles, and 23 international scientific conference presentations. She also takes an active role in projects that aim for protecting and preserving cultural heritage in Mongolia.

From 2013 onwards, she is the head of the Mongolian Association for Tibetan Studies, and a board member of the "Philosophy and Religious Studies" a scientific journal at the NUM, "The Tibetan Studies" at the Institute of Linguistics and Literature, Academy of Sciences, and a member of the editorial board of the "Diaspora" academic journal at the Hankuk University, South Korea.



S.Yanjinsuren has been involved in numerous government projects and initiatives, such as serving as a member of the National Standardization Committee and the Consumer Protection Committee from 2016 to 2020. She was also a member of the National Emergency Commission from 2020 to 2021 and held a deputy chief position at the Council of Academics and Scientists under the National Emergency Commission of Mongolia during the global outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

In 2016-2020, she worked as a member of the working group to develop the National Program for the Protection of Consumer Rights, also she was a member of the Working Group on the Law on Competition, the Law on the Protection of Consumer Rights, and the Law on Advertising. Furthermore in 2020, S. Yanjinsuren worked as a member of developing group of the "Government Action Program for 2020-2024" effectively.
